<p>General Comments</p> <p>On the day of my visit the children had just sat down for their snack. The main room was very well set up with the tables arranged to create smaller groups, which gave the children a chance to interact with each other peacefully while they ate. The environment was divided into sections for different kinds of play, such as a drama section, ball pit, reading nook, a quiet area and a small nook for children who want a few minutes to themselves, to name a few examples. One educator had a group of children playing in the afterschool room which gave them more options for play.</p> <p>The transition from lunch to free play, to outside play, was smooth, the educators played a song for clean up and helped the children tidy and then get dressed for outside play. Two of the educators used the fenced in outside play area while the other educator took his group to the little forested area adjacent to the center. There were multiple play invitations in both locations with the fenced in play area playing music and bubbles, chalk, mud kitchen, Tetris and the forested area had a tub they brought out full of outside toys although the favourite activities in this area were puddles and mud.</p> <p>Staff were kind, gentle and patient with the children. They were engaged with the children and joined them in their play and imaginative games. They were always mindful of safety and supervision with boundaries respected and the attendance forms kept up, and the children accounted for with regular head counts at all times. Staff files and child files were up to date and organized. The play areas were kept clean and picked up and the children's learning stories and art projects were on display and available for the children to look at. The afterschool children do not arrive until around 3 pm and another visit will be made at another time to observe them.</p>
