Monitoring Inspection with the focus of following-up on orders for compliance from previous inspection.

Children and educators observed during indoor play, outdoor play, transitions, lunch time and the beginning of nap. Improvements have been noted within the environments, with some orders for compliance remaining.

Some small break out areas have been added throughout the facility to allow educators to engage with smaller groups of children.

Educators observed sitting with children during lunch and engaging in meaningful conversations.

QA Monitor discussed using smaller containers for open-ended art materials, that can be refilled more often. This may alleviate some of the dumping of materials. Setting up materials in a way that is inviting on the table will encourage children to explore the materials.
