Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including outdoor play, dramatic play, small world play, sensory opportunities and open-ended art.									
The two/three and three/four rooms have a variety of invitations set-up for the children to explore. Materials have been added to the environments that support the children's current interests (construction, dinosaurs, and transportation).									
Documentation is displayed throughout each environment that supports the children's interest and learning experiences. Learning stories, photos of the children, open-ended art pieces and children's words are displayed for the children to revisit.									
The fours room is in need of materials and more defined interest centers. QA Monitor discussed with Manager during inspection.									
Hand washing routines were observed after outdoor play and before meals. English muffins with jam and milk were served for morning snack. Homemade chicken and vegetable soup with bread and butter was served for lunch.
