General Comments
Monitoring Inspection: Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning/afternoon including outdoor play, sensory opportunities, open-ended art, exploring magnetic blocks, painting and stories. Each room is set up with a variety of invitations for the children to explore freely. Each room has a sensory bin set-up that supports the children's current interests (dinosaurs, ocean animals and construction). The 2/3s Room and the 3/4s Room have learning stories, photos and children's art pieces displayed for children to revisit their experiences. The 4s Room is in need of some documentation that supports the children's current interests. Educators were observed encouraging children to get dressed for outdoor play independently. Pillow covers in the 4s Room are becoming unclean. To be laundered. Nap time was observed today. The environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap. Wraps with Roast Beef, Turkey or Ham and clementines were served for lunch. Children were observed to choose what they wanted in their wrap. Cucumbers, celery and crackers were served for afternoon snack. Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines, at arrival and before mealtimes.

General Comments

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
