When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility the children were engaging in free play activities. The operator encouraged the infants to share the play materials.

The operator is very kind and compassionate with the children in her care. At nap time, the operator picked up and cuddled each infant singing them a song while rocking them to sleep and then placed the children in their assigned cribs in the home.

At snack time the children had home made pancakes, tangerines and water.

The indoor and the outdoor learning environments are lovely and full of materials for the children to engage with.
