General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at Laura's Learning Garden to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, one infant was going down for a morning nap. Once the infant was settled the children transitioned back downstairs to the main play area.

Several new resources and play materials such as a busy board, light cube and magnetic tiles have been added since the last Monitoring Inspection. A new light cube arrived at the home this week. The children were eager to play with it this morning, using a small remote to change the color. The Operator brought a basket of different colored sensory pouches for the children to put on the cube. The Operator gave several gentle reminders before working together to put toys away to prepare for morning snack. The Operator made cleaning up a playful activity to encourage the children to join in. Proper diaper changing procedures were observed and the children washed their hands before transitioning upstairs to the kitchen area for snack time.

On the menu for today the children were having cereal with milk and blueberries. The Operator put on some music and sat with the children as they ate. As the children finished, hands and faces were washed. One child was observed playing with a dump truck and paper balls as they waited for their peers to finish eating. Once morning snack was done, the group got ready to go outside. The outdoor environment had a variety of play materials available for the children to use such as shovels, sleds, mud kitchen, a play stroller and balls.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Operator was actively engaged with the children throughout the visit, sitting and playing with them and offering hugs and praise. Current learning stories, pictures of the children with their families and artwork were observed. Child profiles were reviewed today and contained all required documents.
