General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at Laura's Learning Garden to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the Operator was cleaning as the children napped. Shortly after arrival, the Operator gently woke the children up. The children were given time to wake up slowly before diapers were changed. Artwork, learning stories and family pictures were displayed throughout the indoor environment. The Operator explained to the group they would be having afternoon snack outside today. Outdoor shoes, sunscreen and hats were put on before the children transitioned outside.

The Operator brought a tray outside for their water bottles and snack. The children sat together at a small picnic table with an umbrella. For afternoon snack the children had yogurt and fresh strawberries, which matched what was posted on the Menu for today. As the children finished eating, hands and faces were cleaned before the children engaged in play. Some children were observed pushing a baby stroller while others rolled wooden stumps on a pathway. Once all the children had finished snack, the Operator filled up a water table. The children used bowls, spoons and other play materials from the mud kitchen to make soup. Later the children used plastic animals in the water table, pretending they were jumping in and swimming.

Families were greeted as the children got picked up at the end of the day. It is evident the Operator has formed positive relationships with the families. The Operator and families were heard discussing plans for tomorrow as they will be having a birthday party for one of the children in attendance. The Operator explained she usually decorates the indoor environment, and the family is planning on bringing a treat for the children. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Operator was patient with the children and spoke to them in a soft and gentle manner. The Operator was attentive with their needs and respectful towards the children
