- -Nutrition

During the visit, the ratio was respected. The parents are well informed of important information regarding the operation of the facility. The outdoor play area materials and equipment are varied and in sufficient quantity for all the children present. There's easily accessible storage space for the personal belongings of each child.

The QAM had a discussion with the operator regarding the designation requirements. The operator has already completed the 10 hours of professional learning and QIP is up to date.
