 -Visit to the learning center for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -Each child has an easily accessible space for personal belongings, which is labeled with the name of the child and used only for the intended child. -Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children -Individual space is provided for diapers and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained. Changing area is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink. Children are always supervised during diaper changing. -Centre has the proper number of functioning and available toilets and sinks, one potty chair or training seat is provided, and a steps or platforms are provided to allow children to reach regular sized toilets or sinks. -An inclusive environment is provided for all children -Daily activities into the center shows purposely planned and documented programming that gives children, Time, and space for a free choice of play experiences, indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity either individually or in a group. Children have opportunities for various forms of literacy and to express creativity and interests, to explore the arts and sciences and to experience accomplishment and success. They have opportunities to problem solve and to develop trusting, respectful and puportive relationships. -Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector. -Administrator and educators hold a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate.
