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<p>General Comments</p> <p>A renewal inspection occurred today.</p> <p>Upon arrival at the childcare facility, Inspector observed the children engaged in reading the story "Mix It Up" with their educator. During the story, the educator asked the children open ended questions about what they thought would happen next and what would happen when they mix two colors together. After the story, an invitation was observed set up for the children to create their own "Mix It Up" creations by mixing assorted colors of paint with cotton balls, fingers, and hands.</p> <p>The children were also observed during morning snack and free play. During free play, the Inspector observed the children drawing pictures, cutting with scissors, reading books, digging, and scooping in the sand table. Before lunch, the children were observed heading to the "Maker Space" area of the school where an invitation was set up in a Tuff Tray for the children to create shakers with plastic eggs and beans. A matching game for the eggs was also observed set up for the children.</p> <p>Upon arrival back to the childcare room before lunch, the children were observed reading a book with their educator called "Billions of Bricks." The educator, after completing the book, invited the children to explore bricks. Inspector observed the children creating with cube bricks and making tall towers, a city, and a snake.</p> <p>During lunch, Inspector observed that the school had a lunch program in which parents/guardians can participate in for their children. Some of the children were observed participating in this while other ate lunches that were provided from home.</p> <p>Inspector observed that on the walls of the childcare room that each child has their own bulletin board in which samples of their art is displayed for them to revisit at any time.</p> <p>Educator was observed actively engaged with the children, down at their level and on the floor with them in their learning and play. Positive interactions were observed and positive child guidance techniques were also observed being used during the inspection.</p>
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General Comments

All items under the Early Childhood Services Act/Regulations were in compliance at the time of the renewal inspection. Facility is recommended for license renewal.
