The nest needs to be removed from the playhouse.

The facility has been re-organized with definitive centers including a dramatic play area, block area, craft/puzzle area and a quiet area. A shelf has been added to store the children lunch boxes and artwork. This helps to keep the entrance less cluttered and more organized.

The outdoor play needs to have a shade structured added. This could be umbrellas, wind sail or a gazebo. More open-end play materials are needed in the outdoor place.

The facility seemed to be running smoothly during the visit.
