<p>Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed an unlocked cupboard under the sink in the kitchen that contained cleaning and toxic products such as Pine-Sol , Febreze Air Mist , Liquid PLUMR clog destroyer , Finish jet dry ultra , Finish power ball , Clorox on the go wipes , Windex , Lysol wipes, vim cream and goo gone. The Quality Assurance Monitor noticed the lock was loose and wasn't locking properly. The administrator was able to lock the lock and informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the lock will be fixed or replaced. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>
