General Comments
<p>Children engage in free play at arrival. Children independently chose what they are interested in and the environment is set up for children to easily access materials. Children played with blocks, puzzles, lego, stuffies, kitchen and books. Tanya read to a small group of children, sitting beside them on the couch. As soon as the music began children began to clean up, familiar with the routine. After clean up, everyone sat on the mat to have a discussion, today's topic was climate change and some world events. Tanya shared a story about iguanas in Florida and a video was shown, a great use of technology. After this discussion, the children jumped up to do Zumba with the guidance of a video. Snack followed after and Meghan lead a discussion during snack asking what items could be reduced, reused, recycled or composted.</p> <p>A glass cabinet is located within the environment for children to place their creations. I viewed one child placing his lego creation inside beside a nest, found pussy willows, and other creations.</p> <p>The group had a discussion about miracle berries today and watched a short video. Then, the groups separated and the school age group made a list of foods to have with miracle berries and the younger children sat at the table to create miracle berries with play dough.</p>
