### General Comments

Renewal inspection completed today.

Children's learning environments are set up with a variety of materials for children to engage with. Invitations on tables and around the rooms, welcome children and invite them to play.

Documentation of individual and group learning with photos and descriptions are posted creating a sense of belonging and demonstrates that educators are valuing, listening and thinking about children's learning.

Books are available in all interest centres and labelled shelves and toy bins support children's literacy learning.

Educators were observed engaging with children in play, listening attentively as children speak, and responding appropriately to cues of younger children.

Discussed providing opportunities for open-ended art as opposed to crafts. Open-ended art provides children with opportunities to explore the properties of objects and create in their own way. Recommendation to reach out to your Learning Consultant for professional learning opportunities that support process versus product art.

Outdoor play, diaper changing, and hand washing were observed during inspection.
