General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

The children in all classrooms were observed engaging in play using action figures and blocks, reading stories, singing, and dancing, using puppets, and coloring. Transitions in all rooms ran smoothly. All classrooms were observed going outside. The educators were observed having positive interactions with the children. The classroom environments were calm, and all the classrooms had a wide range of open-ended materials that were open and ready for all the children to explore throughout the day.

Documentation and pictures of the children reflected the children's on-going learning interests. Educators displayed the children's learning in each classroom environment as well as the outside play environment. This allows children to revisit their previous play experiences as well as values the outside play environment.

There were a variety of materials for the kids to play with outside, such as balls, sand, and sand toys, mud kitchens, and utensils, reading nook with books, and art materials.

Hand washing, diaper changing, and naptime routines were observed.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, infant toddler daily sheets, nap sheets, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children's files was completed.

Licensing staff discussed the following with the Administrators:

- 1. The Administrators are to ensure the Educators are following the cleaning schedules for toys and child washrooms.
- 2. The Educators are to ensure water bottles and cups are sent home daily to be washed.
- 3. The Administrators are to ensure proper cleaning of wall dividers.
- 4. The Administrators are to support all classrooms with adding additional art materials to the art centers.
