Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector observed that a NB Curriculum framework-English certificate was missing in one of the 2 staff member files verified.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector observed that consent for administering medication was present in the 5 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Oct 26, 2022	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector was informed that one of the educators was taking their break outside of the facility, the ratio was not respected in one of the classrooms. During lunch breaks when children are napping, staff members included in the child-to-staff ratio must remain on-site and are easily accessible within the building. The operator must ensure that child-to-staff ratio is maintained at all times in the same age group.
