Comments: Inspector observed a child twenty-two (22) months of age sleeping in a pack 'n play in the infant play area. Once children turn fifteen (15) months they are to transition sleeping on a nap/map cot unless there are extenuating circumstances, which can be discussed with the Inspector or Quality Assurance Monitor at that time. Discussed with Administrator and the child will move to nap map/cot beginning September 18, 2025, as it was during nap/quiet time that the observation occurred.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Sep 18, 2025	
Comments: Inspector observed a child sixteen (16) months of age sleeping in the separate infant nap/rest area. Children over fifteen (15) months of age are to be always supervised during nap time. Fifteen-minute checks were being conducted on the child; however, the child must be moved out of the infant nap/rest area unless a staff member is present in the infant nap/rest area room. Administrator indicated the child will move to the main play area to rest/nap with the other children who are over fifteen (15) months of age on September 18, 2025. Inspector agreed as the child was currently sleeping when the observation occurred.			

General Comments
A monitoring inspection occurred today. Children were observed during inside play, lunch, nap/quiet time, and outside play. Discussed with the Administrator the Public Health Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in Early Learning and Childcare Facilities. A copy of this was emailed to the Administrator for their records.

General Comments

Napping of infants over and under fifteen (15) months was also discussed with the Educators and Administrator. Educators were observed actively engaged with the children in their learning and play during the inspection.
