Comments: Administration of medication form missing parent signature. Obtain parent's written consent on medication form prior to administering going forward.

Comments: Masks: Many educators were wearing masks within their rooms and outdoors with their groups of children. Masks are not allowed to be used by educators in their regular interactions with children in Early Learning and Childcare facilities (as per p.10 of the Recovery Phase document). When interacting with other adults during the drop off and pick up process, a community mask should be worn by that staff member if social distancing is not possible (p.4 of Recovery Phase document). Upon drop off to the facility, children are being taken to a common sink to wash hands prior to joining their designated group. Children should be taken directly to their classroom to wash their hands within the washroom designated for their group.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jul 31, 2020	
Comments: Particles (brick/mortar) are crumbling from the bottom of the brick wall within the school age room along the wall of the construction center. This powder like residue is collecting on the floor within the children's play space. The wall needs to be repaired.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Jul 30, 2020	
Comments: Some toys were unclean within the Tong room (washer/dryer, play kitchen, and construction center), to be cleaned. The rainbow styled mat within the afterschool room is also collecting debris and needs to be vacuumed/cleaned.

General Comments
<p>Monitoring Inspection-COVID-19 Recovery Phase.</p> <p>Children were observed during outdoor play today, reading books and exploring invitations set up throughout the room.</p> <p>Observed educators engaging with the children and supporting imaginative play.</p> <p>Washroom facilities: Washrooms must be cleaned/sanitized between groups of children if they are being used by more than 1 group. If children from separate groups are sharing the same bathroom, hand washing, activities and meal breaks may need to be staggered to meet the physical distancing requirement.</p> <p>Children within each group must stay 2 meters away from children within a different group and their space. When a separate entrance to a group space is available, this should be used rather than walking through another groups room. If educators and children must share a common entrance to a room, rearranging the space, and the addition of signs or arrows taped to the floor may be necessary in order to ensure the physical distancing requirement can be met.</p> <p>Recommending that facility review the COVID-19 Recovery Phase: Guidance to Early Learning and Childcare Facilities document with all staff.</p>
