<p>Renewal inspection completed today.</p> <p>Preschool children's learning environments are set up with a variety of materials for children to engage with. Invitations on tables and around the rooms, welcome children and invite them to play. Documentation of individual and group learning with photos and descriptions are posted creating a sense of belonging and demonstrates that educators are valuing, listening and thinking about children's learning. The school age room has improved with clearly defined interest centres and invitations, providing a more engaging environment for the children.</p> <p>Educators were observed engaging with children in play, listening attentively as children speak, and responding in an appropriate manner to challenging behaviours.</p> <p>Outdoor play and hand washing were observed during inspection.</p>
