General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

When the Inspector arrived the children and staff were eager to share it was Christmas in July. During the inspection, the children had a special surprise. Mrs. Claus surprised the children with a cold treat after lunch.

The children in all classrooms were observed playing in the outdoor environment. The children were observed climbing, drawing snowmen in the sand, riding toy bikes and cars, swinging on swing, and sliding down the slides. Transitions to and from outside ran smoothly. All classrooms were observed going outside. The educators were observed having positive interactions with the children. The classroom environments were calm, and all the classrooms had invitations for play with a wide range of open-ended materials that were ready for all the children to explore throughout the day.

Documentation and pictures of the children reflected the children's on-going learning interests. Educators displayed the children's learning in each classroom environment as well as the outside play environment. This allows children to revisit their previous play experiences as well as values the outside play environment.

Hand washing, diaper changing, and naptime routines were observed.

General Comments

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children's files was completed.

Recommending that the Administrators ensure proper training occurs for new staff members.
