Comments: Surfacing around the dome climber, swings, and slide was observed to be depleted. Additional surfacing is required in these areas to ensure adequate depth and impact absorption. The protective surfacing should also be raked daily to maintain the required depth and provide appropriate fall protection.			

General Comments
Renewal Inspection: A renewal inspection was conducted during the morning and afternoon for the pre-school children. The children were observed participating in a variety of activities both indoors and outdoors. Indoors, the children were observed during snack, lunch, and nap time, engaging in an art activity, playing with Lego, and reading stories. Outdoors, the children were observed playing in the sand with cars and trucks and using the play equipment. Documentation was current and reflective of the children's past play experiences. Children's artwork was displayed throughout the rooms. Educators shared that some of the children's current interests include bugs, water play, planting, and gardening. The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drill records, daily attendance records, a sample of children's files, all staff files, and professional learning records. All required documentation was appropriately posted on the parent information board. Handwashing practices were also observed during the inspection. At the time of the renewal inspection, a few areas were noted to be collecting dirt and debris. The inspector informed the on-site administrator that Public Health would be notified.
