Comments: Infant Outdoor Play Area: The outdoor play has a variety of larger toys however, it is lacking in smaller items. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: balls, pots, pans, utensils, bowls, pylons, small vehicles, age-appropriate loose parts, magnifying glasses, containers (for dumping/pouring), water play materials, mark making materials and materials that support the children's interests.
