## General Comments

A renewal Inspection occurred today.

Children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor play environments. The educators were observed having meaningful conversations with the children, listening carefully allowing them time to think and express how they are feeling. Licensing observed flexible areas that are rich in opportunities for sensory learning, social interaction, language, exploration, manipulation, and representation. They are purposely designed and planned to enhance children's healthy development and learning.

Infant room had snack and went for a walk around the neighborhood. Infants were observed playing with trucks, animals, books, and dancing to music. Educators were observed playing with the children. In the afternoon the children celebrated a friend's birthday. Sounds is a current learning interest and documentation of sound painting and sounds shakers reflected this.

Toddler room was having a dance party. Risky play was observed as children used their gross motor skills to jump off low shelving. Books throughout the environment were displayed supporting children's literacy. Natural open-ended materials have been added to the classroom.

Preschool room was observed playing with playdough. Educators removed the chairs allowing the children to sand, stretching their muscles and manipulating the playdough in different ways. Open-ended materials, including popsicle sticks and scissors were added to the table. Children created their own bouncy balls, made pizzas, and people using the materials.

Educators accommodate children's emerging interests by making children's contributions and thinking visible through displays, documentation, photos and artwork.

During outdoor play the children were observed collecting leaves and making piles with them. Educators were observed engaged in play with the children.

Snack and lunchtime observed. Nap routines observed.

All staff files and random review of children's file were complete.

Recommending administrator has all staff read the diaper changing procedures and sign off once completed.
