General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 9, 2025.</p> <p>The children were observed engaging in activities in the indoor and outdoor environments, including during transitions between these spaces.</p> <p>The children participated in a variety of physical activities such as running, jumping, sliding, and digging. The children transitioned indoors for lunch. Prior to eating, handwashing and diapering routines were followed. Diaper changing procedures were clearly posted and observed to be followed.</p> <p>Infant Room Interests: Educators noted that infants are currently interested in sensory experiences, sounds, and music. This interest is reflected in the room's environment, including posted documentation and a "Senses" learning web.</p> <p>2/3 Room Interests: Children in the 2/3 room are exploring dinosaurs and bugs. Evidence of this interest is displayed through a learning web and related materials.</p>

General Comments

Preschool Room Interests: Preschool children are currently engaged with topics such as animals, insects, wildlife, and imaginative play centered around family roles.

Several forms of documentation were visible in the indoor environment. These included learning stories, photographs and children's artwork.

A clearly visible and prominent area is designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incidents logs and daily attendance records.

A Conversation took place with the Operator about the following:

Ensuring that all child medications are present and located in the room where the child is currently.

The toilet in the 2/3 bathroom is currently non-functional. The Administrator has contacted a plumber to address the issue.

Ensuring water bottles are accessible to all children both inside and outside the facility at all times.

Mouse droppings were observed in the infant playpen and on the infant change table. This was immediately discussed with the Administrator.

- The Administrator cleaned the affected areas while licensing staff were on site.
- The Administrator stated she would contact an exterminator.
- Licensing will follow up with Public Health regarding this matter.
