General Comments

Infant Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including riding in cozy cars, using the rocking teeter-totter, playing in the playhouse, and digging in the sandbox. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in cars, blocks, trains, baby dolls, and music.

Two-Year-Old Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including pulling wagons, using cars and trucks, looking for bugs, digging in the sandbox, and using the balance board. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in sensory activities, specifically painting, bugs, and body movement activities.

Preschool Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including going down the slide, playing in the sandbox, looking for bugs, and navigating an obstacle course created by the children. The children indicated that they are currently interested in art, playing family roles, picking flowers, outdoor play, and bugs.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, one educator file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation with the administrator occurred on the following:

- Educators are to ensure the outdoor play yard is kept clean and free from garbage and broken toys.
- Educators are to ensure the sandbox on the infant deck is always accessible to children. Educators indicated that the sandbox was only being opened in the afternoon.
- The operator is to ensure the infant play area contains materials that are varied and available in sufficient quantity for all children present. Licensing observed that the storage bin for outdoor materials was empty. The children did not have materials to use in the sandbox; a couple of bowls and shovels were obtained from the two-year-old play yard at the request of Licensing. Licensing discussed with educators bringing materials from the indoor classroom to the outdoor environment to ensure infants have materials to engage with.
