## **General Comments**

The facility operates in a multi-use building. Inspector was informed that some children from the facility attend a summer camp during certain hours of the day. During time of inspection at the facility, the inspector observed children under 12 years old being left unsupervised at the camp. While children from the facility attend the camp, the children are no longer under the supervision of the facility as this is a service separate from the licensed facility. Inspector asked the operator to communicate with the parents of the children attending the childcare and camp the difference between the services offered while attending the childcare and the camp. Ratios at the Childcare were respected during time of inspection.

During time of inspection a volunteer was observed supervising a child while using the washroom. Volunteers and staff under the age of 19 can be calculated in ratio and must never be left alone with children.

Inspector observed the educator and volunteer engaging and interacting with the children during free play by offering a variety of activities to choose depending on the childs interest. The educator was also observed playing in the gym with the children and following the interest of the different children of her group.
