Comments: During the follow-up inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that all staff member had a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate. Deficiency is now compliant.			
12(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may be, and a check with the Department of Social Development at least every five years.	12(1)	Apr 16, 2024	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the operator's criminal record check \ vulnerable sector check that was expired had not been renewed. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator for the second time that the criminal record checks \ vulnerable sector check must be done every 5 years.			
12(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may be, and a check with the Department of Social Development is conducted on each individual before he or she becomes a staff member.	12(2)	Apr 18, 2024	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that a criminal record checks \ vulnerable sector check was completed prior to employment. Although during the follow-up inspection a new staff member arrived on site and did not have a completed check with social development. The staff in questions was asked to leave the premises and will be able to return once a check with social development is completed.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that all staff members file had a copy of a criminal record check \ vulnerable sector check. Deficiency is now compliant.

<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed a new staff member arrived on site, while the Quality Assurance Monitor was verifying the staff in questions file the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the check with social development was not completed. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all staff members must have a copy of a check with social development in their staff file and explained to the operator that the staff in questions must leave the premises and will be able to return once a check with social development is completed.</p>

<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that all staff member had a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.</p>	30(3)	Apr 25, 2024	
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection report, the Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator regarding the damages to the building and the plan to do the repairs. The operator confirmed having patched the inside of the ceiling in the gym area to stop the leak and confirms that the outdoor of the roof will be fixed this summer. The operator also confirmed that the rest of the repairs will be completed over the weekend.</p>			
<p>32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	32(1)(a)	Apr 18, 2024	Apr 18, 2024
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe that art and craft materials were added for children. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommends the operator refers to the Operator Manuel for required equipment and materials for school-age children to ensure the materials and equipment meets the needs and interest of all children. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.</p>	32(1)(d)	Apr 18, 2024	Apr 18, 2024
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the couch that needed to be fixed or replaced was no longer in the play area. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			
<p>39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;</p>	39(2)(a)	Apr 12, 2024	Apr 18, 2024
<p>Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the cabinet containing the shaving cream was still not locked. The Quality Assurance Monitor also noticed a lighter in the same cabinet. The operator immediately took the lighter and shaving cream and stored in lock storage. Deficiency is now compliant.</p>			

### General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a follow-up inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.

During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that as per previous monitoring inspection the children were watching television. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that television should not be used daily to fill gaps in the day. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommends that the operator refers to the operators manual regarding the use of television, and recommends using other options of activities to fill gaps in the day.

The quality Assurance Monitor also had a discussion regarding a staff member's first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the operator that they must verify with work safe to ensure that the certificate provided by the staff in questions meets the requirements of Occupational Health and Safety Act.
