| Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the wholes in the walls were not fixed. The Quality Assurance Monitor also noticed that the floors were fixed with duct tape. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator for the 3rd time that the holes in the walls must be fixed and that the Quality Assurance Monitor will verify with Public Health to ensure that the floors being fixed with duct tape will meet their requirements. | | | |
