## General Comments

A discussion was had between the operator and the Quality Assurance Monitor regarding the hours of operations. The Quality Assurance Monitor mentioned arriving on site at 2h40 and no one was present at the facility a few minutes later at 2h45 , a parent arrived to drop off their child at the facility where no one was present. The operator arrived at the centre with children at 3h07 where the child waiting with his parent was able to enter the facility. The operator explains that the child attends a school out of their pickup district and the parent has been driving the child for a few years now due to the request of wanting to attend the centre , the operator confirms that the parent is well aware and ok with waiting for the operator or educator to arrive to enter the facility.

A discussion regarding the staff in question that does not contain a valid first aid and valid cardiopulmonary certificate doing bus runs were also had. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that the staff in question can't be left alone with children , meaning they can't do a bus run while they will be alone with the children in the bus. The operator explained having no choice in reason of having no other staff available. The operator confirms that the staff in question will be completing their first aid and cardiopulmonary course on February 28, 2025. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that the staff in question can't do the bus run until they have received their first aid and cardiopulmonary certificate.
