The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a follow-up i Child-to-staff ratios were maintained throughout the visit.	nspection.				

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor attempted to engage in a discussion with the educator; however, due to the loud music and the noise from the bouncy castle fans, it was difficult to hear. The Quality Assurance Monitor requested that the educator gather a few children and move to the front room to continue the conversation.

In the front room, a discussion took place regarding the volume of the music in the back room. The Quality Assurance Monitor inquired about how the educator ensures the safety of the children, particularly in noisy environments. Concerns were raised about the inability to hear a child in distress inside the bouncy castle due to the loud music and fan noise. Additionally, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that the back room's layout prevents visibility of the entrance, and with the current noise level, it would be difficult to hear if someone entered the facility.

The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended lowering the volume of the music to improve safety and communication. The educator agreed to reduce the volume.
