Comments:	During the follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the outdoor play area was maintained in a safe condition and free of hazards. However, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted a small amount of litter, such as wrappers, still present. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended that educators bring a garbage bag when going outdoors to collect any remaining litter. It was then observed that educators followed this recommendation by bringing a garbage bag and picking up the garbage left outside. Deficiency is now compliant.
