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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including dramatic play, board/card games, art, and exploring invitations set-up by educators. In the Seniors Room a small group of children were playing Charades, and the others were drawing and creating with open ended art materials. In the Junior Room the educator was playing a game of UNO with a child. A small group of children were "cooking" and dressing up in the dramatic play area. A few more children were engaging with cars and experimenting with a car ramp that was built by the educator.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation on planning sheets, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (acting, sports, art, Bingo, and cars).</p> <p>In response to recommendations left during last Monitoring Inspection new board games, card games and real-life dramatic play materials have been added to the environment.</p> <p>Written evacuation procedures to be added to floor plan evacuation map at each door in the Senior and Junior rooms. Monthly fire drills are documented.</p> <p>Yogurt tubes and cereal were set out for afternoon snack; children could choose when they ate and served themselves.</p> <p>Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.</p> <p>New staff file (2) review was completed. One staff file was not complete at time of inspection. QA Monitor was able to confirm digital Criminal Record Check and SD Check during inspection. Checks and signed statement are to be added to file on site. Ensure all staff who hold a position at the site have a complete file.</p>
