Follow up to COVID 19 Monitoring Inspection.

All outstanding orders for compliance from COVID-19 Recovery Phase Monitoring Inspection are in compliance.

Bus drop off to the centre was observed today. The facility has implemented protocols to ensure the safety of the children. Children are met at the bus by an educator, who is wearing a community face masks. The children then enter the facility and are greeted by their prospective "Pod/Group" educators. Children form a line with their educators, with ample distance between groups to ensure physical distancing. Once all the children have come in from the bus, the educators take their individual groups to their room, where the children put their backpacks/jackets away, wash hands, then participate in various learning opportunities. The children were observed having snack, playing inside and playing outside with their respective "group/pods".

The inside learning environments have been divided to support maximum group size of 15 as per the COVID-19 Recovery Phase document and their are numerous learning materials available for the children to engage and interact with in their groupings.
