Comments: Some materials are in need of cleaning within both groups. -Train table accessories -Lego and storage bin (within room closest to the door) -Dramatic play kitchen (within room furthest from the door) -Doll house and dramatic play structure (on side closet to the door) The disposable table cloths covering the tables are also worn and some have holes. These are to be removed/replaced.

Comments: Toxic products (bleach/cleaning products) observed within cupboard under sink in the kitchen during today's inspection. These must be locked. Products were moved to locked storage closet today.			

<b>General Comments</b>  Completed renewal inspection today. The children were observed to be engaged in creative art, gross motor activities inside within the "Kids Zone" area, dancing, and playing mini stick hockey. The educators were engaged with the children and the rooms were set up for their arrival. There is a variety of materials accessible within each group and photos displaying the children's recent experiences. Some children shared stories about the "Minute to Win It" challenges that they held during the week of March Break as they reflected on photos displayed within the room. Painted rocks were also noted on the shelves within the room. Ensure the dramatic play areas reflect the children's interests. What else could be added to the environment to peak the children's curiosity within this area? Discussed storage of toxic products, and medications.
