Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed in one classroom that one child present was not signed in on the attendance sheet. Staff members must ensure that daily attendance records are accurate at all times. The staff member immediately added the time of arrival of the child. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct a monitoring inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor is present during morning free play, both indoors and outdoors. The Quality Assurance Monitor is also present when a class returns from a community walk. The Quality Assurance Monitor observes the children engaging in a variety of activities such as building with magnetic shapes, reading books, and role-playing in the play kitchen. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observes the staff members interacting with the children through their choice of play. The Quality Assurance Monitor verified these items: - Ratio and maximum number of children - Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility - Child records - Incident records - Daily activities - Indoor play area - Indoor play area materials and equipment
