**General Comments**

Monitoring visit performed today. This is my first visit to this facility. It is bright (lots of windows ) and inviting. All toys, equipment and furnishings are accessible and at children's eye level.

- \*Staff are tracking children's arrivals and departures.
- \* During my visit children were involved in a variety of activities - some ages are interested in balls and cars, others are interesting in playing family and blocks, some other ages are into books, play doh. The 4's were also playing red light. It is -20c today so I did not observe outdoor play. If the temperature improves the children will be going outside in the PM. Educators can always plan for other active play opportunities in the classroom on days that is too cold to be outside.
- \* I reviewed staff programming. Educators are documenting children's learning experiences. Just a reminder to date your documentation that is posted. Thank you.
- \*Educators were observed engaged with the children, providing assistance, asking and answering questions. Lots of interaction and conversation. Appropriate child guidance practices observed.
- \* Please remind staff that hot beverages are not permitted in children's play areas. Thank you.
- \* I discussed with the Operator and suggested an easy way to document non reportable incidents. Refer to section 6.6.1 in the operator manual. The Operator has decided to use Appendix 15 going forward to keep an incident report log in chronological order in a binder in the office area. Once educators have parents sign off on the report so they are made aware, the most recent incident will be stored at the front of the binder.
- \* Children were observed eating lunches brought from home and getting ready to go down for a nap in the infant and 2's room. Other children enjoyed quiet time activities.
- \* I reviewed staff training requirements with the Operator and discussed section 11 (c) ii (A) and (B).
