General Comments

The indoor play environment is set up with learning centres that promote the overall development of the children. There are many natural components in the indoor setting including objects that the children are finding and learning about in the outdoor classroom. The Operator stated that all of the children spend more time outside then inside and this was evident at the time of visit. Today it was pouring rain, and the children were out mud sliding in the forest.

Pre -planned programming and documentation of the children's learning is evident in all of the age groups at the facility. There were pictures, artwork, portfolios, journals, and webbing as examples. Educators were seen at the children's level interacting with them in a very kind and gentle manner. They were seen playing and taking an active part in conversations. There was very little conflict seen between the children at time of visit.

All documentation was easily verified by licensing staff. The Operator is organized and keeps all required records to meet regulations.

Although the Operator stated that they have limited issues with behaviours, licensing staff advised operator to ensure that educators are documenting continuous problematic behaviours and the steps taken to resolve any issues that may arise. The Operator was advised to have parent(s) sign such incident logs as needed.

There is evidently more learning centres set up in the fenced outdoor playspace. The Operator stated that a solid division will be used to separate the infants from the preschoolers or children will use the outdoor play space at different times.

Licensing staff can now recommend facility for licensing.
