The natural and wooden materials in the rooms gives the facility a home-like feeling. The educators have sensory bins and matching books set up in the rooms. Books are on display in various areas in the rooms, and there are plenty of seating areas for quiet moments or reading. Due to the fact that facility uses the forest as the playground the children are taught where the boundaries are. During the inspection the children took me on a tour of the area they were playing in, showing me the areas they could, and could not go. On the day of the visit the children were enjoying sliding on the snow and ice. The educators are constantly counting the children and at times will blow a whistle, which means the children have to come to the meeting area.
