The facility is nicely set up with soft lighting, plants, neutral colors, natural and realistic materials in all the rooms. This gives the facility a home like feeling. Play centers are properly defined to allow the children to learn, explore and be creative with a wide variety of materials available. There is evidence of purposely planned programming as seen with the lesson plans, documentation, and children's artwork displayed on the walls. The children's interests have been about animals, so the theme this week is Safari Animals. The children are learning about the various safari animals. One group created their own book about animals. During diaper changing, the educators were observed singing to the children and asking questions " where are your eyes?", "where is your nose?". Proper procedures were followed.
