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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. The indoor environment was bright, organized and welcoming with a large variety of materials accessible to the children on low shelves, bins and wicker baskets. Upon arrival, some children and infants were still resting as it was quiet time. The children and infants who were awake were observed playing outside. As the group inside woke up, they prepared for outdoor play and joined their peers outside.</p> <p>Water bottles, first aid kits and a music speaker were brought outside. There were 2 large wooden boxes full of outdoor play materials such as shovels, rakes, trucks, buckets and colorful plastic blocks, all in good condition. Conversations were heard between Educators and the Operator regarding sending reminders home to families to send in sun hats and sunscreen with the warmer temperatures coming. Educators were reminded to keep a close eye on the infants to ensure they didn't get overheated. Educators were well spread out to ensure proper supervision and Educators were observed checking in with children to ensure they were protected from the sun.</p> <p>Some children were observed running, climbing and jumping off a large tire, playing in a wooden playhouse and using a variety of play materials, practicing scooping and pouring rocks. Another group of children were observed laughing, dancing and singing. When it was time to go inside for afternoon snack. each class was divided into smaller groups which allowed for a smooth transition. Hand washing was observed before the children sat to eat. As the children got picked up at the end of day, families were greeted and attendance records were updated.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. All Educators were engaged with the children in their play, kneeling outside to play in the play kitchen and offering pushes on the tire swings. Educators were observed dancing and singing, offering hugs and high fives throughout the afternoon. Records were reviewed for new staff who were on site today. The files were organized, easily accessed and contained all required documents.</p>
