Comments: There is a white shelf in the preschool room that is not very sturdy. When the door is opened the shelf tips. This shelf should be secured to the wall. Carpets, rugs and quiet area cushions need to be vacuumed. The black leather storage box in the two's room needs to be cleaned as there was dirt, debris and food particles inside it.

<p>Comments: Two puzzles and six books were found in the infants area. No open craft materials were found in the preschool room. Coloring books, crayons and scissors were found in the craft area. No puzzles were found in the two's room. The afterschool room needs to have age appropriate materials. The puzzles found in the room was for three year old children. Empty game boxes were also found on the shelves.</p>

<p>Comments: Puzzles throughout the facility are missing pieces. The work bench in the two-year-old room is extremely wobbly. The screws need to be tightened. The "count & win sports center" need to have the batteries replaced as the item is not fully functional without the batteries. The play kitchen in the afterschool room is missing parts.</p>
