<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon arrival for inspection, the preschool children were observed to be intently listening to the educator reading a book in the cozy corner. Following this activity, the children moved into handwashing and snack time. It was evident that the children were familiar with the routine at this time of day. All were engaging in comfortable conversation around the snack table.</p> <p>Preschool documentation has taken on many forms and is posted in the room and in the hallway for children and parents to enjoy. Lovely displays of the children's paintings, drawings, printing and art creations.</p>

General Comments

Discussed valuing documentation and the benefits of making learning visible within the learning environment (referenced the Collaborative Assessment Tool).

The school age children were observed to circulate the room based on their interests. Some children were drawing, some were painting a pumpkin, while others were playing cards and chilling on chairs with their friends in the quiet area.
