A renewal inspection was conducted today.
The children were observed during morning free play, morning snack, outside play (going for a walk), lunch and quiet time. Handwashing was also observed at various times throughout the day.
The learning environment has a variety of age-appropriate materials for the children to interact and engage with.

During the inspection the children were eager to tell the Inspector all about their Halloween adventures, costumes they wore, how many candy treats they received and their favourite treat.
During the inspection in the outside play area, it was observed some clapboard siding boards are beginning to deteriorate on the side of the building in the outside fenced play area, adjacent to the main road. Discussed with executive director and she will make operator aware of this.
