Comments: One glue stick was observed. More glue (sticks and liquid) to be added to the art and crafts area.			

General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed during inside play and during the transition to snack time. Several well-defined learning / play centers were observed. Some of these centers included: loose parts, arts and crafts, building, reading, and printing / mark making. Children were observed building with the magnetic tiles and Lego. Educator stated that the magnetic tiles are a favorite right now. Smaller sized magnetic tiles have recently been added to the classroom. Some children were observed in the arts and crafts center, drawing, and making pictures for their families. Educators stated that the children are presently learning about families. A Family Web was observed on the wall, with several family related learning stories nearby. Children were also observed "signing in". During this activity, children were observed printing their names. The Arts and Crafts center contained a variety of materials. Several crayons, organized by color, were observed in wooden containers. Several sharpened pencil crayons were also observed. It is recommended that the facility adds markers to their arts and crafts center. A conversation was had regarding glue. Educator stated that the children, at times, misuse the glue. Quality Assurance Monitor recommends that glue be kept in a see-through container, with a lid, and be kept in the arts and crafts center.
