11(c)(ii) The qualifications and training requirements for administrators and educators are as follows: (c) at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre, (ii) on and after July 1, 2020, (A) at least 50% of educators must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent in the opinion of the Minister, and (B) an administrator must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent in the opinion of the Minister.	11(c)(ii)	Dec 19, 2025	
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observes that only 1 out of 3 employees holds a one-year certificate in Early Childhood Education. The regulations require that 50% of the educator possess this certificate or an equivalency recognized by the Minister. One of her employees holds an ECE certificate that is not listed in Appendix 25 of recognized Early Childhood Education programs in New Brunswick. The administrator must send a request to the exemption team to see if this certificate can be recognized by the province. If the certificate can't be exempt, then the administrator must submit a plan to her Quality Assurance mentor explaining how she intends to reach the 50% requirement.

Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observed that the most recent inspection report was not posted. The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, and or probationary license must be posted. The inspector informed the administrator who printed and posted the last inspection report as required. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the review of 6 children's files, the inspector observes that 1 file contains only one emergency contact. Each child's file must include the name, address, and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contacts.

Comments: During the rest period, the inspector observed that two mattresses were positioned very close to each other. The inspector informed the educator that all mattresses must be spaced at least 46 cm apart. The educator then moved one mattress, ensuring there is now a minimum of 46 cm between both mattresses. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. A discussion takes place with the administrator regarding employee files. All employee files must be complete, with no missing certificates or information. During the inspection, the inspector observes morning snacks, indoor and outdoor free play, lunch time, rest period, and afternoon snacks. The arrival of school-age children from school is also observed. The ratio is maintained throughout the renewal inspection.
