Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the operator's Social Development check had expired. The operator must ensure that their Social Development check is renewed at least every five years.			
12(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may, and a check with the Department of Social Development is conducted on each staff member and associated person at least every five years.	12(3)	Apr 22, 2026	
Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one staff member's Social Development check and criminal record check/vulnerable sector check had expired. The operator must ensure that all staff members have their criminal record checks/vulnerable sector checks and Social Development checks renewed at least every five years.
