## **General Comments**

Name of operator

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 30, 2025.

Children were observed during indoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in the garden located in the outdoor play space and enjoy making mud pies in the mud kitchen. Educators were observed using positive language and offering gentle reminders to support children's interactions and engagement.

Parents of children present at the center are granted entry at any time. Outdoor play is offered for at least one hour in each four-hour block when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. A clearly visible and prominent area is available for posting the license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance.

The daily routine is posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are displayed in a prominent location. Rest periods are arranged to meet the individual needs of each child. The room was inviting and thoughtfully arranged, with materials set out to encourage play and exploration. Books selected for the space reflect the children's interests, and children's artwork is displayed at eye level, with names and dates included.

Traffic areas and outdoor walkways are clean and free from clutter. Drinking water is accessible to children throughout the day. Various forms of literacy are present in the indoor environment, supporting language development and early learning. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, reflecting children's learning, interests, and experiences.
