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General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the home at 9am for a monitoring inspection. Upon arrival, the children were engaged in free play activities such as playing with magnetic tiles and playing with dominos. The operator was observed engaging in play with the children. As some children arrived later in the morning, the operator was observed greeting the children and inviting them to play. As the children became interested in another activity, the operator was observed setting out additional accessories so that the children could enhance their activity. The operator was engaged in the children's play activities.

Later, the children were prompted to clean up before transitioning to a new activity. The operator encouraged a few children to use the washroom and supervised them. The children's hands were washed after using the washroom. The children returned to free play activities such as coloring, playing in the dramatic play kitchen, with costumes and magnetic tiles. Around 11:30am, the children were prompted to start cleaning up and get ready for lunch. Transitions were smooth as the operator was observed cleaning up with the children and praising them while they cleaned up. The children's hands were washed before they sat down at the table to eat. The operator supervised the children while they ate.

The parent information board was verified and found to be complete. Toxic products were locked in the washroom closet. The diaper changing procedure was posted in the washroom. The children's personal belongings were properly stored and labelled. The indoor environment was clean and well organized. Various and sufficient indoor play materials were located on low accessible shelving. The operator has a binder of learning stories, and a few posted in the indoor environment. The operator was on touch with the children's needs by offering them water and food during the day.
