General Comments
Licensing Staff arrived at Tippy Toes to conduct the renewal inspection. Upon arrival, the children were engaged in free play while waiting for their last friend to arrive. The Operator explained that the children enjoy playing dress-up. The children were excited to put on Halloween masks and made sure that everyone had one. The Operator joined the children and offered to help them put on tutus. Shortly after Licensing Staff arrived, the children cleaned up and washed their hands for morning snack. After finishing their morning snack, the children were encouraged to use the washroom before going outside. Once everyone had their hats and outdoor shoes on, the children lined up to go outside, bringing their water bottles with them. During outdoor play, the children participated in a variety of activities, including ring toss, using chalk to color rocks, and playing in the mud kitchen. Because of the rain the previous morning, some of the mud kitchen accessories were dirty. The children worked together to put the dirty dishes in the sink. The Operator explained that later in the day, they could bring out soap and warm water to wash the dishes. The transition back inside for lunch was smooth. The children appeared familiar and comfortable with the daily routine. They washed their hands and then sat together at the table for lunch. The Operator sat nearby and engaged in conversation with the children. Hands were washed after lunch and diapers were changed. The children who napped settled in their playpen or cot while the children who don't nap played with puzzles and read books. Fire drills are conducted monthly, along with an outdoor maintenance check. Child and staff files were reviewed and contained all required documentation. All documents were easily accessible and well organized.
