General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection took place today. Educators greeted the children at the school, took attendance, and then proceeded to the outdoor playground, where children were actively engaged in sledding, making snowballs, and racing on the equipment. Indoors, children's open-ended artwork was displayed throughout the room, including paintings above the labelled cubbies on Side A. The dramatic play centre featured aprons, a kitchen set, and realistic play food arranged neatly, along with a child-sized table and chairs. Shelves held games such as Monopoly, Sorry, puzzles, and Subtraction Bingo. The art centre offered scissors, pencils, crayons, markers, glueable beads, paper, and a chalkboard with chalk. A repurposed playhouse served as a bookshelf, and a cozy reading corner included chairs, foam mats, and a large rug. The sensory table displayed an "Every Season" theme with wooden materials, seashells, and pinecones, accompanied by a related book. On Side B, low labelled shelves held magnetic tiles and games like Connect Four and Who's This in reusable bags. A calming corner provided large foam chairs, a rug, and games such as Would You Rather. Additional materials included an ice-cream maker invitation and LEGO displayed on the shelves. Children's birthdays and a photo collage documenting activities throughout the year were posted on the wall. A large dollhouse with accessible bins of furniture, cars, and animals was also available. Fire drills were observed and completed, and all bathrooms were clean and functioning. The parent board contained all required documentation, including monitoring reports, renewal inspection information, fire and evacuation drill records, licensing contact details, and fire and public health inspection reports.</p>
